

October Fishing Report

water temp: 85 degrees

water level: 9.67ft

Bass fishing on Dunlap has started to pick up. October has historically been a great month for fishing and with some rain it can be even better. Lake levels are still low so be careful.

With the ongoing heat and sun beating down almost everyday, fishing docks can still be a consistent pattern. Finding docks with brush on them can be a bonus. Throwing soft plastics seems to be productive most days. Try a fluke or senko type bait rigged weightless. Using lighter line will get you more bites, but increase your chance of breakage.

Also, try a jig in a natural color such as green pumpkin or watermelon. The fish seem to be lazy in their search for food, so casting to high probable areas is best. Your bites will probably occur on the fall so be ready. The fish should start to chase bait with more aggression so fast moving baits might be more productive in the weeks to come.
